- ❖ Please make sure your house number can be seen from the road in the dark.
- ❖ Please ensure your house number can be seen when approaching from both directions.
- ❖ Please remember, that if you have a medical emergency, especially at night, time spent looking for your house number may have serious consequences.

Once we find your address, can we get to your front door?

As a land-owner, in the Cowichan Bay Improvement District, please be advised that the Cowichan Bay Volunteer Fire Rescue, may not be able to respond to locations where access routes do not provide:

- ❖ Driveways have a clear width of 6 metres;
- ❖ Overhead clearances are not less than 5 metres;
- ❖ The existing maximum vertical grade should be 8.00% and in special circumstances up to, but not exceed 12.00% subject to Cowichan Bay Volunteer Fire Rescue approval.
- ❖ All current access routes must have road loads capable to support firefighting equipment, including culverts and bridges
