

Opportunity to Bid - Snow Clearing and Ice Management Services

The Cowichan Bay Improvement District (The "CBID") is seeking bids from qualified providers for the provision of snow clearing and ice management services.

The successful bidder shall provide:

- a. Evidence that they carry Commercial General Liability insurance coverage for a minimum of \$2,000,000 per occurrence with no general aggregate. The policy must contain a cross liability clause and include the use and operation of unlicensed and specially licensed machinery. CBID must be shown as Additional Insured and be provided with 30 days advance written notice of cancellation or material change to the policy.
- b. Confirmation that they shall respond to the CBID property on a 24/7 basis within two hours after an accumulation of 2 inches of snow occurs.
- c. Assurance that they will assume full responsibility for the performance of snow clearing & sanding &/or salting services, accepting that there may be vehicles parked in the parking lot, and that they shall provide all the required equipment and materials.
- d. Confirmation that they are prepared to enter into an agreement for a period of 3 years.
- e. Confirmation in writing that If the successful bidder is injured or has an accident on the CBID's property, the CBID will not accept liability
- f. Acknowledgement that the CBID is aware that weather conditions may change rapidly and without notice and that the successful bidder assumes no liability for such changes in conditions.
- g. Confirmation that they shall provide additional sanding, salting or other melting agent to the CBID property within 2 hours of a request from CBID.
- h. A cost proposal that identifies an hourly rate.
- i. It is expected that the bidder will be pro-active, based on their best knowledge of predicted weather conditions.
- j. Provide a WorkSafeBC clearance or exception letter.
